Lessons for the future from an effective and rights-based response to the COVID-19 pandemic

Parliamentary Assembly

- 1. The Parliamentary Assembly refers to its Resolution 2329 (2020) on Lessons for the future from an effective and rights-based response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 2. The Assembly believes that the Council of Europe's human rights mandate requires the reestablishment of comprehensive intergovernmental co-operation and co-ordination in the field of public health, including with a view to building a regional system capable of supporting the responsible international and European Union institutions in their endeavours to ensure effective pandemic preparedness and reaction.
- 3. The Assembly thus recommends that the Committee of Ministers urgently re-establish an intergovernmental steering committee on public health as a first step towards this goal, and consider how the European Directorate for the Quality of Medicines and HealthCare (EDQM) of the Council of Europe could be associated with the committee's work.
